

1. REMINDER:

The child's name will be used with a reminder of the desired behaviour.

2. WARNING:

A verbal warning will be given.

3. REFLECTION:

The child will be told to take some time for reflection. This will usually take place at the end of the lesson, in the pupil's own time. Incidents of this nature will be logged on CPOMS >Behaviour.

4. TIME OUT:

If the behaviour continues a "time-out" will be issued. The "time out" will take place in front of, or in, the School Office, and the Headteacher will be informed. Incidents of this nature are also logged on CPOMS >Behaviour and parents will be informed.

DETENTION:

For incidents of a more serious nature, a lunch time detention will be issued, supervised by the head teacher or assistant head teacher. These will be logged on CPOMS >Behaviour and parents will be informed.

IN-SCHOOL ISOLATION:

Where there are continued breaches of the school's behaviour code or the misbehaviour is extremely serious, the head teacher will issue a supervised, in-school isolation for a limited period, usually between one and three days. Parents will be informed by letter beforehand

EXCLUSION:

Exclusions will be issued under the exclusions policy and criteria. Notification must be sent to parents and the LA.
